



Diabetes and Asthma Management Programs Medical Exemptions

As part of the OhioHealthy Plan, participants in the Diabetes and Asthma Management Programs receive 100 percent coverage on certain medications used for the primary management of diabetes and asthma **after their medical plan annual deductible has been met**. The medications listed below are covered at the standard 80%/20% coinsurance rate, **after your medical plan annual deductible has been met**, and are not covered at 100 percent. Diabetes medications:

- Juvissync – Alternative therapy is available with Januvia and Simvastatin.
- Afrezza – Alternative therapy is available with Insulin.
- Welchol – Primarily used as add-on therapy for cholesterol and has minimal effect on A1C.

Asthma medications:

- Nucala – Only available through Specialty Pharmacy.
- Xolair – Only available through Specialty Pharmacy.
- Oralair – Only available through Specialty Pharmacy.
- Immunotherapy – Not available in the pharmacy. Only prescribed and provided through allergist visits.
- Daliresp – Not indicated for Asthma.
- Brovana – Not indicated for Asthma.
- Arcapta – Not indicated for Asthma.
- Tudorza - Not indicated for Asthma.
- Xopenex – Albuterol recommended as alternative therapy.
